# WELCOME TO ACADEMY

The Academy Neighborhood, located in the middle west section of the City of St. Louis, is in the Cabanne District. Surrounding neighborhoods include Fountain Park to the east, the Central West End to the south, Visitation Park, West End, and Hamilton Heights neighborhoods to the west, and Kingsway West to the north.

Soldan High School, named after the St. Louis educator F. Louis Soldan, is located in the neighborhood. Today it is a magnet high school that focuses on international studies.


The Cabanne Branch of the St. Louis Public Library system is on Union Boulevard. It was the second of the original six branches, along with the Central Library, built in 1906 with a generous gift by Andrew Carnegie.

The area that the neighborhood occupies today was originally part of a large farm owned by Jean Pierre Cabanne who came to St. Louis in 1806 and acquired the land through a Spanish land grant. Architecturally, most residential buildings in the Academy Neighborhood were built between 1890 and 1910 for the city's growing middle class.

The residential neighborhood south of Page Boulevard falls within the Mount Cabanne and Raymond Place historic districts.

After the B'nai Amoona Temple opened in the Academy, a large Jewish population called the neighborhood home in the 1920s and 1930s.



# POPULATION CHANGE




#### **Changes in Population Demographics**

From 2020 to 2021, there has been a decline in population. Specifically, the Black or African American population has decreased from 4,489 to 2,326, while the Caucasian population has decreased from 294 to 179.

The data are being retrieved from U.S. Census Bureau, American Community Survey 5-Year Estimates. Estimates of urban and rural populations, housing units, and characteristics reflect boundaries of urban areas defined based on Census 2010 data. As a result, data for urban and rural areas from ACS do not necessarily reflect the results of ongoing urbanization.




### AGE BY SEX




### **Educational Attainment Comparison**

#### ZONING MAP OF ACADEMY NEIGHBORHOOD




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
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### **Residential Habits of Academy's Working Population**

Job Categories in Academy


Job categories in the Academy include health care, social assistance, accommodation, and other jobs unrelated to management, professional, and education.

# JOB GROWTH IN ACADEMY BY INCOME




### Comparing Job Growth in 2020 and 2021


# CRIME OVER THE PAST TEN YEARS

### **CRIME BY TYPE**




### **Crime Statistics in Academy Neighborhood**

According to official records, there have been 582 crime cases reported in the Academy. A majority of these incidents are related to property crimes, while society, personal, and unspecified crimes make up 22%, 21%, and 20% of the total, respectively.


# MEANS OF TRANSPORTATION
