

This program is a way to give back and aid in our mission of stabilizing the neighrbohoods surrounding the medical campus.



















This year, we were able to assist 39 local families through our Holiday Outreach program, <u>plus</u> 112 seniors through our Elderly Care Program.

How did we do it?

39 families and individuals were adopted by departments of the Washington University School of Medicine and BJC HealthCare.

We received \$16,140 in donations to help families in need with utility bill assistance and groceries through our Holiday Outreach program.

We delivered 112 Elderly Care Packages to lowincome seniors.

With \$10,800 in donations to our Elderly Care program, we were able to provide each senior with household items and Schnucks gift cards.

A total of \$26,940 was donated by the wonderful members of our community to the Holiday Outreach and Elderly Care programs.
